A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 26-2-411 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to

2 licensing and inspection of mobile meat, poultry, or seafood sale vehicles, so as to change

3 a license expiration date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** Code Section 26-2-411 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to licensing and 6 7 inspection of mobile meat, poultry, or seafood sale vehicles, is amended by striking 8 subsection (a) and inserting in lieu thereof the following: 9 "(a) Any person who sells, displays for sale, or offers for sale at retail any fresh or frozen 10 meat, poultry, or seafood in, on, or from a mobile vehicle shall prominently display in such 11 mobile vehicle a current and valid license issued by the Department of Agriculture. Such 12 license shall be issued by the department following the satisfactory inspection of such mobile vehicle and the meat, poultry, or seafood offered for sale therefrom to determine 13 14 compliance with the laws of this state and the rules and regulations of the Commissioner 15 and the payment of a license fee of \$50.00 per vehicle per year or any portion thereof. All licenses, including without limitation any previously issued license which was current and 16 valid on July 1, 2004, shall expire 12 months from the date of issue on December 31 of 17 each year. Any license may be renewed for any subsequent year upon a satisfactory 18 inspection of the mobile vehicle and its contents and the payment of the license fee." 19
