## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the Purple Heart Highway; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, members of the armed forces of the United States have defended and continue  
3 to defend our nation against those who transgress and act against our national interests and  
4 seek to tarnish the principles of freedom; and
- 5 WHEREAS, countless soldiers, sailors, airmen, and marines have been wounded and have  
6 given their lives in defense of the United States; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the Purple Heart medal is awarded to those service members who have been  
8 killed or wounded in the line of duty; and
- 9 WHEREAS, these recipients of the Purple Heart medal deserve the thanks, recognition, and  
10 respect of all Harris County citizens for their service and devotion to our county, state, and  
11 nation; and
- 12 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the many achievements,  
13 accomplishments, and contributions of the recipients of the Purple Heart medal be  
14 appropriately recognized.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
16 GEORGIA that the length of Georgia Highway 354 beginning just west of Pine Mountain  
17 at Highway 18 and continuing east through Pine Mountain Valley to the intersection of  
18 Highway 116 is designated as the Purple Heart Highway, and the Department of  
19 Transportation is authorized and directed to place and maintain appropriate markers  
20 designating the Purple Heart Highway.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
2 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the Department of  
3 Transportation and to the Chipley Historical Center of Pine Mountain.
