A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Hawkinsville High School Red Devils football team; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Hawkinsville High School Red Devils football team recently completed its
4 first undefeated season since 1954 and became the state Class A football champions with a
5 thrilling 18-8 victory over Lincoln County; and

6 WHEREAS, on December 20, 2003, the Red Devils won this dramatic state championship
7 game in front of a packed house of over 8,000 fans at Bobby Gentry Stadium; and

8 WHEREAS, during the past season the Red Devils scored a school record of 499 points and
9 won their second consecutive region championship; and

10 WHEREAS, tailback Jeremy Marshall set school rushing records of 2,294 season yards and
11 333 single game yards, quarterback Todd Coley set school passing records with 117
12 completions out of 206 attempts for 2,294 yards and 32 touchdowns with only eight
13 interceptions, and defensive end Charles Johnson was rated among the top 100 college
14 prospects; and

15 WHEREAS, the phenomenal performance of the team is a clear indication of the superior
16 athletic ability, the commitment and hard work, and the unity and focus of each member of
17 the team; their outstanding offensive and defensive talents; and the unmatched leadership of
18 their beloved head coach, the courageous Lee Campbell, and his staff; and

19 WHEREAS, for the first time in 44 years, the Hawkinsville Red Devils have proved to its
20 opponents, fans, and this state that it is, once again, the winningest football team in Georgia.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
22 the members of this body commend the Hawkinsville High School Red Devils football team

1 for its unparalleled successes on the football field and extend their sincerest best wishes for
2 continued success in the future.

4 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the team and to Coach Lee
5 Campbell.
