A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Mr. Douglas W. Strohbahn; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia and the National Exchange Club lost one of its most
3 outstanding citizens and loyal members with the passing of Douglas Strohbahn on December
4 19, 2003; and

5 WHEREAS, he bravely served his country during WWII, one of our nation's and the world's
6 greatest times of need, in the South Pacific where he rose from the rank of private to captain
7 and was seriously wounded while serving in the cavalry; and

8 WHEREAS, his professional and Exchange careers were long and illustrious as he worked
9 in the Georgia Cooperative Extension Service in Habersham, Chatham, and Fulton counties
10 and had been president of the Georgia and National County Agents Associations; and

11 WHEREAS, Doug's Exchange Club service began in Savannah where he served as
12 president-elect until he moved to Atlanta and became the Buckhead Club's president and
13 Georgia District Exchange Club President; and

14 WHEREAS, following his marriage to his beautiful wife Annette, Doug relocated to Macon
15 and became a great part of the Exchange Club of Macon and the Macon community and
16 served as club president, Fair Board president, and on many and various club and fair
17 committees and projects; and

18 WHEREAS, Mr. Douglas Strohbahn was a leader wherever he served and was fervent in his
19 dedication to causes that benefited his fellow man, and his love for God, country, family, and
20 friends was his life and for this he will truly be missed.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
22 this body honors the life and memory of Douglas W. Strohbahn, one of Georgia's finest and

1 most selfless citizens, husbands, and veterans, and would like to express deepest regrets and
