#### A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Michael Frisch; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Michael Frisch, a member of Boy Scout Troop 555, has attained the rank of  
3 Eagle Scout; and
- 4 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle Scout Award has been the symbol of the highest  
5 achievement among the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the attainment of this rank indicates that a Scout has developed leadership  
7 ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities that will be  
8 of immense benefit throughout his life; and
- 9 WHEREAS, in order for a Scout to reach this goal, he must earn 21 merit badges, 12 of  
10 which are mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and
- 11 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Michael Frisch has brought honor to himself,  
12 his troop, and his parents and it is both fitting and proper that we recognize and commend  
13 this young man on his honorable achievement.

15 recognize and commend Michael Frisch on attaining the rank of Eagle Scout and for the  
16 great credit he reflects on his community and the State of Georgia.
