- 1 Honoring and commending Olivia Levine; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Olivia Levine, daughter of Elaine and Jim Levine, is a senior at Pace Academy,
3 a member of Temple Zaban, and a brilliant young photographer; and
- 4 WHEREAS, her commitment to her community has led Olivia Levine to be an active
5 volunteer on behalf of Atlanta's homeless by donating her time and talents to the Temple
6 Zaban Night Shelter; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the plight of the homeless in her city has inspired this gifted and compassionate
8 young woman to apply her outstanding skills as an artist and photographer to help fund the
9 Temple's homeless shelter; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the shelter, through the support of the Temple, its members, and private
11 donations, houses, feeds, clothes, and provides counseling services to residents as they
12 transition out of homelessness and back into normal and productive lives; and
- 13 WHEREAS, on September 21, 2003, Olivia Levine held a photography exhibit at Pace
14 Academy for the purpose of displaying and selling her original photographic works to the
15 public and, in turn, donating all proceeds from the show to Temple Zaban Night Shelter; and
- 16 WHEREAS, this remarkable and selfless young woman has gained deserved acclaim and
17 recognition for her artistic work having won a silver key in the state-wide Scholastic Art
18 Competition and first place in a juried photography contest of over 200 entrants, and having
19 studied at Yale University; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Ms. Levine is a shining example of compassion, leadership, and volunteerism
21 this nation, Georgia, and Atlanta can be proud of, for she truly understands that the acts of
22 one individual can make a difference to a community.
