A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Jason Ronberg on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Jason Ronberg, a member of Boy Scout Troop 7 in Savannah, Georgia, received
4 the Eagle Scout Award at an Eagle Scout Court of Honor Ceremony on July 28, 2003; and

5 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle Scout Award has been the symbol of the highest
6 achievement among the Boy Scouts of America; and

7 WHEREAS, the attainment of this rank indicates that a Scout has developed leadership
8 ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities that will be
9 of immense benefit throughout his life; and

10 WHEREAS, in order for a Scout to reach this goal, he must earn 21 merit badges, 12 of
11 which are mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and

12 WHEREAS, Jason Ronberg has demonstrated character and achievement in many ways,
13 including service as a Colonel and Brigade Commander of the JROTC at Windsor Forest
14 High School, 2003 Troop Librarian for Troop 7, and other school and community activities;

16 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Jason Ronberg has brought honor to himself,
17 his troop, and his parents.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
19 the members of this body recognize and commend Jason Ronberg on attaining the rank of
20 Eagle Scout and for the great credit he reflects on his community and the State of Georgia.
