A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Reverend Willard Baxter; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Reverend Willard Baxter has touched thousands of lives in Georgia during a long career as a Baptist minister, law enforcement officer, investigator, and county emergency management director; and
- 5 WHEREAS, though Reverend Willard Baxter has officially retired, he continues to serve his fellow man by remaining active in the volunteer work he loves, such as serving as chaplain of the Hall County Soil and Water Conservation District, as senior sergeant of the Hall County Sheriff's Department reserve unit, and as an active member and volunteer assistant at the church he once pastored, Lakewood Baptist Church of Gainesville; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Reverend Baxter was born in Bremen, Georgia, was ordained a Baptist minister at age 19, and has pastored the Ohoopee Baptist Church in Tinnell, the Stedman Baptist Church in Tallapoosa, the Center Hill Baptist Church in Atlanta, the Welcome All Baptist Church in College Park, the Lakewood Baptist Church in Gainesville, the Belmont Baptist Church in Gainesville, and the Bethel Baptist Church in Bethlehem; and
- 15 WHEREAS, for ten years he was the assistant administrator of the Georgia Baptist Children's Home; and
- 17 WHEREAS, he was a volunteer member of the Gwinnett County Sheriff's Department mounted patrol unit and later served as investigator for the Hall County District Attorney's office and retired as that county's emergency management director; and
- 20 WHEREAS, his long-time hobby has been woodworking, and he has served on the board of directors of the Southern States Woodturning Symposium and of the American Association of Woodturners and has crafted special items such as gavels presented to Federal Judge
