## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring and congratulating Mr. Vincent Jones on his 64 years of service to the *Jackson*  
2 *Progress-Argus*, his state, and his country and on his retirement; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the community of Jackson and the State of Georgia lost one of their most  
4 respected and beloved newspaper editors when *Jackson Progress-Argus* editor Vincent Jones  
5 retired on July 1, 2003; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Jones followed his brother's lead and went to work at the *Jackson*  
7 *Progress-Argus* in 1940 back in the days when the paper was under the ownership of his  
8 father, our nation stood on the brink of war, and Franklin Roosevelt was our Commander in  
9 Chief; and

10 WHEREAS, after spending 20 years writing his personal column, "The Last Straw," Vincent  
11 Jones left the paper to pursue a life in politics, working for the Georgia Department of  
12 Industry and Trade and the United States Savings Bond administration; and

13 WHEREAS, his true love called him back in the late 1970's and Mr. Jones returned to his  
14 hometown of Jackson and the newspaper business and began to write "The Last Straw"  
15 again, as well as two new features, "Voices Out of the Past" and "A Stroll Down Memory  
16 Lane"; and

17 WHEREAS, it is both fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
18 amazing individual be recognized for his 64 years of service in the work force.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
20 this body honors and congratulates Mr. Vincent Jones on his many loyal years of service and  
21 dedication to the *Jackson Progress-Argus*, this state, and his country and we wish him many  
22 happy years in retirement.
