3 season with an impressive 9-1 record and went on to become AAAA state champions with
4 a thrilling 21-6 win over Statesboro High School on December 19, 2003; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the championship game was played at Marist before a packed stadium of
6 supporters and former players; and
- 7 WHEREAS, this is the first state title for Marist since 1989 and is the result of the hard work,
8 dedication, and offensive and defensive talents of the members of the team and the
9 outstanding leadership of Coach Alan Chadwick and the members of his coaching staff; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Coach Alan Chadwick has recently been selected as All-Area Football Coach
11 of the Year; and
- 12 WHEREAS, this football team has established and maintained a proud tradition of excellence
13 with equal emphases on character and academics.
