A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to reincorporate the City of Roswell in the County of Fulton, approved
2 April 19, 2000 (Ga. L. 2000, p. 3844), so as to change the method of selection of the mayor
3 pro tempore; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 **SECTION 1.**

6 An Act to reincorporate the City of Roswell in the County of Fulton, approved April 19,
7 2000 (Ga. L. 2000, p. 3844), is amended by striking in its entirety Section 3.100 and inserting
8 in lieu thereof a new Section 3.100 to read as follows:

9 "SECTION 3.100.
10 Mayor pro tempore.

11 Annually, by majority vote, at the first regularly scheduled meeting in the month of January,
12 the council shall elect a mayor pro tempore from among its members. Should the election
13 result in a tie, the mayor shall vote to break the tie. The mayor pro tempore shall serve for
14 one year or until a succeeding mayor pro tempore is elected; provided, however, that a
15 councilmember shall not be eligible to serve consecutive terms as mayor pro tempore. The
16 mayor pro tempore shall assume the duties and powers of the mayor during the mayor's
17 disability or absence. If the mayor pro tempore is absent because of sickness or
18 disqualification, any one of the remaining councilmembers, elected by the members present,
19 shall be clothed with all the rights and privileges of the mayor and shall perform the mayor's
20 duties."

21 **SECTION 2.**

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
