A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from sales and use taxes, so as to provide for an exemption with respect to sales of certain tangible personal property to, or used in the construction of, certain symphony halls; to provide for conditions and limitations; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.** 8 Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from sales and use taxes, is amended by striking "or" at the end of paragraph (76), by striking the 9 10 period at the end of paragraph (77) and inserting in its place "; or", and by adding a new 11 paragraph immediately following paragraph (77) to be designated paragraph (78) to read as 12 follows: 13 "(78) Notwithstanding any provision of Code Section 48-8-63 to the contrary, from the 14 effective date of this paragraph until January 1, 2007, sales of tangible personal property

- 15 to, or used in the construction of, a symphony hall owned or operated by an organization
- 16 which is exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code."
