A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-5-33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 change of address or name on driver's license, so as to provide that a person's driver's
3 license may show a former address under certain conditions; to provide for related matters;
4 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 40-5-33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to change of
8 address or name on driver's license, is amended by striking said Code section and inserting
9 in its place the following:

10 "40-5-33.

11 (a) Whenever any person, after applying for or receiving a driver's license, shall move
12 from the residence address named in such application or in the license issued to him or her,
13 move from the mailing address named in such application or in the license issued to him
14 or her, or when the name of a licensee is changed by marriage or otherwise, such person
15 shall apply to the department for a license showing the correct name or address within 60
16 days. Failure to change the name or address shall not deem the license invalid.

17 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a) of this Code section, a person's
18 driver's license may show a mailing address that is not his or her residence address so long
19 as he or she receives mail at such mailing address. The department shall record both a
20 mailing address and a residence address for any licensee who provides satisfactory proof
21 of a connection to both a residence address and a mailing address.

22 (c) Any licensee who is a student attending a college or university in this or any other state
23 may maintain the address of his or her parent or legal guardian within this state as the
24 residence address on the records of the department and his or her license."

SECTION 2.

2 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
