## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and expressing appreciation to Vince Dooley; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Vincent J. Dooley was born September 4, 1932, in Mobile, Alabama, and  
3 attended McGill High in Mobile before accepting a football scholarship to Auburn  
4 University, where he was an all-star football and basketball player and received his bachelors  
5 degree in business management in 1954, as well as a later master's in history in 1963; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he served his country with honor and distinction in the United States Marine  
7 Corps and went on to accept an assistant coaching position at Auburn; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he was named head football coach at the University of Georgia in 1963,  
9 beginning a legendary and unparalleled tenure at that great institution, where he has now  
10 served as head coach and athletic director for some 40 years; and
- 11 WHEREAS, his accomplishments and contributions to the university and the State of  
12 Georgia are far too numerous to list, but special mention may be made of his 1980 national  
13 championship season as head coach of the football team, his induction into the College Hall  
14 of Fame in 1994, the 18 national championships won by various athletic teams during his  
15 tenure as athletic director, and the selection of more than 100 student athletes from the  
16 university as first team Academic All-Americans; and
- 17 WHEREAS, in addition to his professional career achievements, he has always given most  
18 generously of his time and efforts to a wide variety of civic and charitable endeavors,  
19 including, to name only one of very many, service as chairman of the Georgia Easter Seals  
20 Society for some 28 years; and
- 21 WHEREAS, he will soon retire from service to the University of Georgia to which he has  
22 devoted 40 years of untiring and exemplary service and to which he has brought great honor.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
2 this body recognizes and expresses appreciation to Vince Dooley for his outstanding  
3 leadership and contributions to the State of Georgia and for all the wonderful moments he  
4 has brought to the lives of the student athletes and supporters of the University of Georgia.
