

Senate Resolution 675

A RESOLUTION

1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to provide that the term of office for
 2 members of the General Assembly shall be four years; to provide for applicability; to provide
 3 for the submission of this amendment for ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

6 Article III, Section II, Paragraph V of the Constitution is amended by striking in its entirety
 7 subparagraph (a) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

8 "(a) The members of the General Assembly shall be elected by the qualified electors of
 9 their respective districts for a term of ~~two~~ four years and shall serve until the time fixed for
 10 the convening of the next General Assembly. This subparagraph shall apply to all members
 11 of the General Assembly taking office on or after January 1, 2004."

12 SECTION 2

13 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
 14 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
 15 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:

16 "() YES Shall the Constitution be amended so as to provide that the terms of office
 17 () NO for members of the General Assembly shall be four years?"

18 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."

19 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
 20 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
 21 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
