## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 7 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to

- 2 barbers, so as to provide that a barber shop may employ apprentice barbers, each of whom
- 3 must be under the supervision of a separate master barber; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
- 4 other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 7 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to barbers, is
- 9 amended by striking in its entirety Code Section 43-7-12, relating to requirements for a
- 10 license to operate a barbershop, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 11 "43-7-12.
- 12 A license to operate a barbershop shall be issued, renewed, or restored to any person who
- can show that such barbershop:
- 14 (1) Provides and maintains such physical and sanitary facilities and equipment as may
- be required by the rules and regulations of the board;
- 16 (2) Does not train more than one apprentice for each master barber at any one time,
- which and each such apprentice shall be under the supervision of a master barber; and
- 18 (3) Does business only at the location shown on the application for licensure."

19 SECTION 2.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
