1 Senator Levetan of the 40th offered the following amendment:

2 Amend the substitute to SB 429 (LC 33 0255S) by deleting line 31 of page 2 through line 15
3 of page 3 and inserting in their place the following:

4 "(d) The property and business of the council shall be managed by a minimum of seven
5 school councilmembers of whom a majority shall constitute a quorum. ~~School~~
6 ~~councilmembers must be individuals who are 18 years of age or older. The number of~~
7 ~~councilmembers shall be specified in the council's bylaws. If the number of~~
8 ~~councilmembers exceeds seven, the number of parent members and teacher members must~~
9 ~~be equal.~~ Members of the school council shall include:

10 (1) ~~Two~~ At least two parents or guardians of students enrolled in the school, excluding
11 employees who are parents or guardians of such students;

12 (2) Two businesspersons, ~~one of whom shall be selected by the local board of education~~
13 ~~and one of whom shall be selected by the other five nonbusiness members of the school~~
14 ~~council from the business partners of the school or, if there are no business partners, from~~
15 ~~the local business community;~~

16 (3) ~~Two~~ At least two certificated teachers, excluding any personnel employed in
17 administrative positions, who are employed at least four of the six school segments at the
18 school; and

19 (4) The school principal; and

20 ~~An employee of the local school system may serve as a parent representative on the council~~
21 ~~of a school in which his or her child is enrolled if such employee works at a different~~
22 ~~school. With the exception of the principal and the business representatives, members shall~~
23 ~~be elected by, and from among, the group they represent. The chairperson of the council~~
24 ~~shall be the school principal.~~

25 (5) Other members as specified in the council's bylaws, such as, but not limited to,
26 students, staff, and representatives of school related organizations. Selection procedures
27 for these members and the business members shall be specified in the council's bylaws.
28 An employee of the local school system may serve as a parent representative on the
29 council of a school in which his or her child is enrolled if such employee works at a
30 different school. With the exception of the principal and the business representatives,
31 members shall be elected by, and from among, the group they represent."
