A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the Atlanta chapter of the National Association of Women in Construction
2 (NAWIC) and proclaiming March 7-13, 2004, as "Women in Construction Week" at the state
3 capitol; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, the Atlanta chapter of NAWIC has for 43 years distinguished itself as the voice
5 of women in construction in the Atlanta metropolitan area; and

6 WHEREAS, the work done by the Atlanta chapter of NAWIC has benefited the Atlanta

8 WHEREAS, the Atlanta chapter of NAWIC has increasingly promoted the employment and
9 advancement of women in the construction industry; and

15 Atlanta metropolitan area and surrounding areas in cooperation with other organizations.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 recognize the Atlanta chapter of NAWIC and its many dedicated volunteers for its steadfast
18 work on behalf and in support of women in construction, and do proudly proclaim the week
19 of March 7-13, 2004, as "Women in Construction Week" at the state capitol, and encourage
20 our citizens to congratulate the organization on its many accomplishments.
