A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Mr. Howard "Doc" Ayers on his many contributions to football in the State of
2 Georgia; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Howard "Doc" Ayers is one of the finest football minds and coaches the State
4 of Georgia has ever produced; and

5 WHEREAS, Howard Ayers coached the Cedartown High School Bulldogs to the school's
6 only state football championship in 1963 and will forever be remembered as a Cedartown
7 football legend; and

8 WHEREAS, he went on to serve 17 years as an assistant coach to Vince Dooley at the
9 University of Georgia and was a member of the Bulldogs' 1980 National Champion coaching
10 staff; and

11 WHEREAS, for his remarkable contributions to football in the State of Georgia, he has been
12 honored with induction into the Georgia Sports Hall of Fame; and

13 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that for his superlative skills and leadership
14 and his outstanding coaching achievements, Howard "Doc" Ayers be appropriately
15 recognized.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 do hereby commend Mr. Howard "Doc" Ayers on his legacy and contributions to and his
18 impact upon the game of football in the State of Georgia and on his induction into the
19 Georgia Sports Hall of Fame.
