A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Mr. W. M. Moss on his many years of outstanding service to law enforcement;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, for 34 years, the City of Cedartown, Georgia, knew but one police chief and
4 his name was Mr. W. M. Moss; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Moss first joined the Cedartown Police Department on February 1, 1945,
6 and served as Cedartown's police chief from 1954 to 1988; and

7 WHEREAS, for three decades, he has contributed to and maintained the peace and safety of
8 the community he serves and to the welfare of its citizens; and

9 WHEREAS, his name and reputation as a law enforcement officer have made him a legend
10 in his Cedartown community; and

11 WHEREAS, as a dedicated law man, he has fought, arrested, and put away criminals ranging
12 from moonshiners and bootleggers to murderers and modern day drug dealers; and

13 WHEREAS, he has consistently conducted his responsibilities with the utmost ability and
14 care, and his professional life and personal integrity have earned him the confidence and trust
15 of the community he respectfully serves.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 commend the courageous and selfless contributions of Mr. W. M. Moss to the security and
18 safety of his community and on his impeccable record and 34 years of prodigious service as
19 the City of Cedartown's chief of police.
