A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Robert Stephen "Bob" Boney of Leesburg; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, he served his country in the United States Marine Corps during World War II;

5 WHEREAS, he served this state as a revenue agent from 1956 to 1966 and as a state prison
6 warden from 1966 to 1986, and he retired from the latter position after 20 years of service;

9 held since 1990 and has been instrumental in the acquisition of a much needed senior citizens
10 center in Leesburg, sidewalks in various areas, and traffic signals at very congested

13 of Georgia, and he has also held offices in numerous other organizations in this state; and

14 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that he be recognized by this body.
