A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 20-2-281 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 assessment of effectiveness of educational programs, so as to provide for the establishment
- 3 by the State Board of Education of policies and standards for the transfer of course credit and
- 4 the waiver of an end-of-course assessment for a student who takes a similar course and
- 5 assessment through an independent program; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 6 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

- 9 Code Section 20-2-281 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to assessment of
- 10 effectiveness of educational programs, is amended by striking subsection (e) in its entirety
- 11 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- "(e) The State Board of Education shall adopt end-of-course assessments for students in 12
- 13 grades nine through 12 for all core subjects to be determined by the state board. For those
- 14 students with an Individualized Education Program, the student's Individualized Education
- 15 Program team shall determine appropriate participation in assessments and identify
- 16 necessary accommodations in accordance with the federal Individuals with Disabilities
- Education Act. The State Board of Education shall adopt policies, procedures, and standards for the transfer of course credit and the waiver of an end-of-course assessment 18
- 19 for a student who takes an equivalent or higher course and passes an equivalent or higher
- 20 end-of-course assessment in a program other than through a local school system."

21 **SECTION 2.**

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
