## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring and remembering the life of Mr. David A. "Mr. McDonald's" Borrow of Cornelia,  
2 Georgia; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, an enthusiastic and positive thinker, David A. Borrow earned a football  
4 scholarship to Youngstown State University, graduated with a master's degree from Kent  
5 State University, and served his nation during the Korean War; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Borrow worked in sales for the Xerox Corporation in Boston, Chicago,  
7 Dallas, and Atlanta before he retired in 1980 as a senior vice president; and

8 WHEREAS, he purchased his first McDonald's franchise in Cornelia and expanded his  
9 business into the Northeast Georgia communities of Clayton, Toccoa, Cleveland, Hiawassee,  
10 and Braselton; and

11 WHEREAS, he was instrumental in founding the North Georgia Youth and Science  
12 Technology Center in Habersham County; served on the Pioneer RESA board; was president  
13 of the Habersham County Chamber of Commerce, the Habersham United Way, and the  
14 Habersham Rotary Club; and a board member of Community Bank and Trust; and

15 WHEREAS, his legendary work ethic and positive influence left an impression on his young  
16 food service employees, many of whom later went on to become physicians, professionals,  
17 and other prominent leaders.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
19 honor and remember the life of Mr. David A. "Mr. McDonald's" Borrow and the immense  
20 impact he had on the people and businesses of Northeast Georgia and express their deepest  
21 condolences to his loving family.
