A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Code Section 20-2-520 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2	building, repairing, renting, and furnishing schoolhouses, so as to require that a board of
3	education notify certain adjacent property owners when such board intends to construct new
4	school buildings or facilities or to demolish or perform major renovations to existing school
5	buildings or facilities; to provide for the form and manner of delivery of such notices; to
6	provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
8	SECTION 1.
9	Code Section 20-2-520 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to building,
10	repairing, renting, and furnishing schoolhouses, is amended by adding a new subsection (d)
11	to read as follows:
12	"(d) When a board of education desires to construct new school buildings or facilities or
13	to demolish or perform major renovations to existing school buildings or facilities, such
14	board shall notify the owner of each parcel of property located within 250 feet of the
15	property line of the property on which the board desires to construct a new school building
16	or facility or to demolish or perform major renovations to an existing school building or
17	facility of the board's intentions. Such notice shall be in writing and shall be made at least
18	30 days prior to the first planning meeting for such construction, demolition, or renovation.
19	The notice shall be sent to such property owner by certified mail or by statutory overnight
20	delivery."
