A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 48-2-15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 confidential status of taxpayer information, so as to provide for additional restrictions
- 3 regarding disclosure of certain information by the state revenue commissioner or an officer
- 4 or employee of the Department of Revenue; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting
- 5 laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 48-2-15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to confidential
- 9 status of taxpayer information, is amended by adding a new subsection at the end thereof, to
- 10 be designated subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 11 "(e) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, taxpayer information or
- records regarding any disputed tax or tax appeal shall be deemed confidential and shall not
- be released, disclosed, or published by the commissioner or an officer or employee of the
- department in any manner whatsoever until such dispute or appeal has been finally
- 15 resolved."

SECTION 2.

- 17 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 18 without such approval.

19 SECTION 3.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
