A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Mr. Cortez T. Scott; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Exceptional Adult Georgian in Literacy Education (EAGLE) Program, the
3 premier adult literacy recognition program in the state, has honored and recognized
4 Georgia's outstanding adult literacy students for 11 years; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the Ambassadors for Literacy are selected from 74 state level EAGLE Award
6 winners among service delivery areas throughout the state who represent thousands of
7 Georgians enrolled in adult literacy programs; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Cortez Scott is a 2003 Ambassador for Literacy; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mr. Scott demonstrated exceptional achievement as a current student in adult
10 basic education; and
- 11 WHEREAS, with strong determination, persistent work and study habits, and exceptional
12 courage, Mr. Scott made adult literacy a top priority, tackling the five-test GED battery,
13 achieving the required score, and earning his GED diploma; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the 2003 Literacy Ambassador, enrolled at Georgia Military College, is
15 acquiring the necessary skills to compete successfully in today's workplace, strengthen
16 family foundations, and exercise full citizenship; and
- 17 WHEREAS, in pursuing his education, Mr. Scott has brought honor to himself, his family,
18 his community, and the technical college as one of Georgia's Ambassadors for Literacy; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Mr. Scott continues to be involved in a variety of state-wide activities
20 promoting the initiatives of the Georgia Department of Technical and Adult Education's
21 Office of Adult Literacy.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body recognizes and
2 commends Mr. Cortez T. Scott for his dedication to promoting lifelong learning and greater
3 awareness of the educational opportunities that are available in local communities throughout

5 endeavors.
