

House Bill 1442

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 5 of Chapter 4 of Title 26 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2 relating to prescription drugs, so as to provide for legislative intent; to provide that every
3 pharmacist shall include the total pharmacy reimbursement cost for a prescription drug on
4 the receipt for the prescription drug; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Article 5 of Chapter 4 of Title 26 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
8 prescription drugs, is amended by adding a new Code section to the end of such article to
9 read as follows:

10 "26-4-91.

11 (a) It is the intent of the General Assembly to enhance consumer responsibility and
12 education regarding the actual cost of prescription drugs.

13 (b) Every pharmacist shall ensure that the total pharmacy reimbursement cost of a
14 prescription drug is printed on the receipt that the patient or his or her representative or
15 agent receives upon the purchase or receipt of such prescription drug dispensed by such
16 pharmacist pursuant to a prescription drug order."

17 **SECTION 2.**

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
