## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring and remembering the life of United States Army Sergeant David Terrell Nutt,  
2 killed in action during the course of Operation Iraqi Freedom; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia and our nation lost one of its finest fathers, husbands,  
4 citizens, and soldiers when Sergeant David Terrell Nutt gave his life on May 14, 2003,  
5 defending his country and the people of Iraq while fighting in Operation Iraqi Freedom; and

6 WHEREAS, Sergeant David Terrell Nutt was born the loving son of his parents, Mrs. Alice  
7 Taylor Nutt and Mr. Winfred Nutt, and was a resident of Coffee County; and

8 WHEREAS, he was a member of the 101st Airborne Company stationed at Fort Campbell,  
9 Kentucky, and was among the first troops to be deployed to the Middle East and among the  
10 first to enter the Iraqi capital of Baghdad; and

11 WHEREAS, Sergeant Nutt courageously gave his life when the supply truck he was driving  
12 was ambushed and came under enemy fire; and

13 WHEREAS, Sergeant Nutt, for his selfless sacrifice, was posthumously promoted to the rank  
14 of Sergeant and awarded the Bronze Star for his heroic bravery while attempting to deliver  
15 desperately needed supplies; and

16 WHEREAS, this patriotic young soldier leaves behind his parents, Alice and Winfred; his  
17 devoted wife, Heidi; and three beautiful daughters, Emily, Sarah, and Hannah; and

18 WHEREAS, Sergeant David Nutt gave his life in the service and defense of his country,  
19 trying to aid someone he did not know, and his heroism will never be forgotten.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
21 the members of this body honor and remember the life and sacrifice of United States Army

1 Sergeant David Terrell Nutt and express to his family sincerest condolences as the rest of the  
2 nation and the State of Georgia mourns his loss.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
4 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the family of Sergeant  
5 David Terrell Nutt.
