

The House Committee on Natural Resources & Environment offers the following substitute to HB 1277:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

To amend Article 1 of Chapter 5 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general provisions relative to water resources, so as to prohibit the installation of certain landscape irrigation systems without rain sensor shut-off switches; to provide for punishment for violations; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

Article 1 of Chapter 5 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general provisions relative to water resources, is amended by inserting a new Code section to read as follows:

"12-5-6.

(a) As used in this Code section, the term 'rain sensor shut-off switch' means an electric device that detects and measures rainfall amounts and overrides the cycle of an irrigation system so as to turn off such system when a predetermined amount of rain has fallen.

(b) On and after January 1, 2005, no person shall install within the Metropolitan North Georgia Water Planning District area created under Article 10 of this chapter any landscape irrigation system that does not have a rain sensor shut-off switch.

(c) Any person who installs any landscape irrigation system in violation of this Code section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor."

SECTION 2.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
