## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Miss Corry McNamara for her selection as Georgia's top youth volunteer for  
2 2004; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, named one of Georgia's top youth volunteers for 2004 by The Prudential Spirit  
4 of Community Awards, Corry McNamara of Snellville, Georgia, was one of only two young  
5 people from this state to receive the coveted award; and

6 WHEREAS, now in its ninth year, The Prudential Spirit of Community Awards program is  
7 a nation-wide contest honoring young people for outstanding acts of volunteerism and  
8 community service; and

9 WHEREAS, the program is conducted by Prudential Financial in partnership with the  
10 National Association of Secondary School Principals (NASSP); and

11 WHEREAS, this year's contest drew over 20,000 high school and middle school entrants;  
12 Corry, a junior, won the singular right to represent Shiloh High School and the State of  
13 Georgia in the high school division; and

14 WHEREAS, Corry planned and implemented a week-long program at Shiloh depicting the  
15 realities and consequences of drinking and driving and is founder and president of her  
16 school's Students Against Destructive Decisions (SADD) chapter; and

17 WHEREAS, for her selfless work, Corry has been honored with \$1,000.00, an engraved  
18 silver medal, and a trip to Washington, D.C., for an opportunity to become one of ten, out  
19 of 104 finalists, to be named America's top youth volunteers for 2004.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
21 the members of this body commend Miss Corry McNamara for her selection as Georgia's

1 top youth volunteer for 2004, and on her selfless dedication to her fellow classmates, school,  
2 and community, and express their best wishes to her as she travels to Washington, D.C.
