## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Court of Honor Drum and Bugle Corps; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Court of Honor Drum and Bugle Corps is a nonprofit organization dedicated  
4 to the performing arts education of young people in Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, each year the corps auditions brass, percussion, and color guard participants for  
6 selection into the Court of Honor Drum and Bugle Corps, the only junior drum and bugle  
7 corps located in Georgia, which represents the State of Georgia in competitions across the  
8 nation; and

9 WHEREAS, in 2002, the corps finished sixth in brass and eleventh overall out of 38 Division  
10 III corps from other states competing at the Drum Corps International's World  
11 Championships in Orlando, Florida, and was honored as the 21st Century Drum and Bugle  
12 Corps Foundation's Horn Grant recipient; and

13 WHEREAS, the corps' recording of the National Anthem is played to begin daily broadcasts  
14 at a popular Atlanta radio station; and

15 WHEREAS, the corps was invited to perform at functions honoring former Governor George  
16 Busbee and U.S. Senator Saxby Chambliss, and individual members of the corps were  
17 invited to play at military funerals and special commemorative events as a part of "Bugles  
18 Across America."

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
20 recognize and heartily commend the Court of Honor Drum and Bugle Corps for its  
21 dedication, hard work, and standard of excellency.
