A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Frenasee Daughety; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Frenasee Daughety is an outstanding and talented artist who has lived in many
3 countries of the world and has gathered diverse experiences that are reflected in her work;

5 WHEREAS, her work is highly valued and displayed in many private collections throughout
6 the state; and

7 WHEREAS, after arriving in Georgia, Mrs. Daughety settled in Columbus for a while and
8 is now a resident of Dublin; and

9 WHEREAS, Mrs. Daughety is a certified art educator with a bachelor's degree of Fine Arts
10 from Columbus State University; and

11 WHEREAS, she has provided art instruction at the adult education level at the Columbus
12 State Continuing Education Program, and also at the elementary education level; and

13 WHEREAS, through her art and teaching, Mrs. Daughety has helped children and adults
14 fulfill their artistic dreams and ambitions; and

15 WHEREAS, the Dublin Rotary Club has sponsored and commissioned Mrs. Daughety to
16 create a portrait of Senator Hugh M. Gillis, Sr.; and

17 WHEREAS, the completed work is now on display in the state capitol building in Atlanta,
18 Georgia; and

19 WHEREAS, the education facility at the Hugh M. Gillis, Sr. Public Fishing Area and the
20 City of Dublin Library will both display the aforementioned portrait.

1 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body heartily and
2 gratefully commends Frenasee Daughety for her artistic efforts in creating the portrait of
3 Hugh M. Gillis, Sr., the longest serving state legislator in the United States and a great
