## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the Rembert Olen McAfee Bridge; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Mr. Rembert Olen McAfee was born in Gordon County on April 20, 1914, the  
3 son of Arthur McAfee and Annie Blalock McAfee, and he lived his entire life in the county  
4 of his birth, and he passed away on November 9, 2003; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Mr. McAfee farmed for 60 years, and his farm on the Coosawattee River was  
6 one of the largest and most productive farms in Gordon County; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he was a member of Oakman Baptist Church and was an Oakman School  
8 trustee, a member of Oakman Community Club, Ranger Community Club, Fairmount  
9 Ruritan, and the ASCS Committee and the Red Carpet Cattleman Association; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he generously donated to the public the land upon which the bridge over the  
11 Coosawattee River on U.S. Highway 411 was built; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Mr. McAfee was honest and straightforward in his dealings and he treated  
13 everyone with equal dignity, be he of high estate or low; and
- 14 WHEREAS, he left behind his beloved wife, Geneva Hunt McAfee, one son, three daughters  
15 nine grandchildren, eight step-grandchildren, nine great grandchildren, and 16 step-great  
16 grandchildren; and
- 17 WHEREAS, it is only right and proper that this great man be remembered and honored for  
18 his life in the community.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
20 GEORGIA that the bridge over the Coosawattee River on U.S. Highway 411 is designated  
21 the Rembert Olen McAfee Bridge, and the Department of Transportation is authorized and

1 directed to place and maintain appropriate markers designating the Rembert Olen McAfee  
2 Bridge.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
4 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to Mrs. Geneva Hunt McAfee  
5 and to the Department of Transportation.
