

House Bill 1207 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 45-12-93 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the  
2 revenue shortfall reserve and midyear adjustment reserve, so as to authorize the General  
3 Assembly of Georgia to appropriate \$208,632,306 for Fiscal Year 2004 and 7 million for  
4 State Fiscal Year 2005 from the revenue shortfall reserve; to provide an effective date; to  
5 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Code Section 45-12-93 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the revenue  
9 shortfall reserve and midyear adjustment reserve, is amended by adding new subsections (e)  
10 and (f) at the end thereof to read as follows:

11 (e) Any other provision of law notwithstanding, the General Assembly of Georgia is  
12 authorized to appropriate \$208,632,306 for State Fiscal Year 2004 from the revenue  
13 shortfall reserve.

14 (f) Any other provision of law notwithstanding, the General Assembly of Georgia is  
15 authorized to appropriate \$7 million for State Fiscal Year 2005 from the revenue shortfall  
16 reserve.

17 **SECTION 2.**

18 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law  
19 without his approval.

20 **SECTION 3.**

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
