## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 45-12-93 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 revenue shortfall reserve and midyear adjustment reserve, so as to authorize the General
- 3 Assembly of Georgia to appropriate \$208,632,306 for Fiscal Year 2004 and 7 million for
- 4 State Fiscal Year 2005 from the revenue shortfall reserve; to provide an effective date; to
- 5 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 45-12-93 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the revenue
- 9 shortfall reserve and midyear adjustment reserve, is amended by adding new subsections (e)
- and (f) at the end thereof to read as follows:
- 11 (e) Any other provision of law notwithstanding, the General Assembly of Georgia is
- authorized to appropriate \$208,632,306 for State Fiscal Year 2004 from the revenue
- shortfall reserve.
- 14 (f) Any other provision of law notwithstanding, the General Assembly of Georgia is
- authorized to appropriate \$7 million for State Fiscal Year 2005 from the revenue shortfall
- 16 reserve.

SECTION 2.

- 18 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 19 without his approval.

SECTION 3.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
