

Senate Resolution 799

A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Industry, Trade, and
2 Tourism, and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers with respect to "Great Lakes of Georgia"
3 website; urging the inclusion of certain additional lakes on the website; and for other
4 purposes.

5 WHEREAS, the collaboration of the Department of Natural Resources and the Department
6 of Industry, Trade, and Tourism with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in creating a website
7 called "Great Lakes of Georgia" has been an outstanding success and example of interagency
8 cooperation; and

9 WHEREAS, the joint venture website highlights the federally authorized Corps of Engineers'
10 lakes in Georgia, including Allatoona, Carters, Clarks Hill-Thurmond, Seminole, Hartwell,
11 Lanier, Russell, George, and West Point; and

12 WHEREAS, the website further offers visitors important travel destinations including
13 lodging, fishing, and recreational opportunities; and

14 WHEREAS, we encourage the joint venture website partners to include Georgia's federally
15 authorized Tennessee Valley Authority lakes, including Nottely, Chatuge, and Blue Ridge,
16 for further website development and economic promotion.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 commend the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Industry, Trade, and
19 Tourism, and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers on the success of the website and their
20 interagency collaboration and encourage the inclusion of Georgia's federally authorized
21 Tennessee Valley Authority lakes on the website.
