1 Commending Alton C. Crews Middle School on its Pay for Performance Award; and for

11 WHEREAS, the 68 schools that received the Pay for Performance awards for the 2002-2003

12 school year went the extra mile to participate in this program; and

13 WHEREAS, Alton C. Crews Middle School proved it was not afraid to set higher standards

14 for itself and worked hard to reach its goals of excellence; and

WHEREAS, awards are made to schools, not to individuals, and, for the determination of exemplary performance at the school site, criteria relates to the overall educational performance of the school in areas related to student outcomes and achievement; and

18 WHEREAS, for its exemplary efforts and achievement, Alton C. Crews Middle School was19 awarded \$130,456.74 by the State of Georgia.
