

Senate Bill 546

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 5 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,  
2 relating to children and youth services, so as to provide for availability of information in  
3 child welfare agencies relating to recall notices on unsafe child care products; to provide for  
4 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Article 1 of Chapter 5 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
8 children and youth services, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

9 "49-5-23.

10 (a) Any agency, department, or office that regulates child welfare agencies shall make  
11 available to such child welfare agencies at the time of application for initial or renewal  
12 certification or licensure information concerning contacting the U. S. Consumer Product  
13 Safety Commission to obtain recall notices on unsafe child and infant products.

14 (b) Child welfare agencies shall post the phone number and website of the U. S. Consumer  
15 Product Safety Commission in a location visible to parents and visitors. The notice shall  
16 also advise such parents and visitors on how to obtain recall notices on unsafe child and  
17 infant products."

18 **SECTION 2.**

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
