- 8 1960, began a practice in 1961, and entered politics in 1965 when he was elected solicitor
- 9 of state court; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Judge Gunter was elected to the office of state representative for the 11th
- 11 district, serving from 1967 to 1972; and
- 12 WHEREAS, he served as president of the Georgia Association of Plaintiff's Trial Attorneys;

- 14 WHEREAS, he was elected secretary-treasurer of the Council of Superior Court Judges in
- 15 1979, president elect 1980-1981, president 1981-1982, retired in 1992, and served as a senior
- 16 judge from 1993 to 2003; and
- 17 WHEREAS, he was a member of the Mount Airy Lodge No. 141 F&AM and was a Shriner,
- 18 Emeritus Yaarab Temple, and a former Kiwanian; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Judge Gunter was a member of Camp Creek Baptist Church where he taught
- adult men's Sunday school class.
