

Senate Resolution 811

A RESOLUTION

1 In memory and honor of the life of Judge Jack N. Gunter and expressing condolences; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Judge Jack Norman Gunter was born in Greensboro, North Carolina, on
4 December 13, 1921; and

5 WHEREAS, after graduating high school, he was a United States Army Air Corps aviation
6 cadet and would become a squadron commander and squadron adjutant in World War II; and

7 WHEREAS, Judge Gunter graduated from John Marshall Law School, passed the bar in
8 1960, began a practice in 1961, and entered politics in 1965 when he was elected solicitor
9 of state court; and

10 WHEREAS, Judge Gunter was elected to the office of state representative for the 11th
11 district, serving from 1967 to 1972; and

12 WHEREAS, he served as president of the Georgia Association of Plaintiff's Trial Attorneys;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, he was elected secretary-treasurer of the Council of Superior Court Judges in
15 1979, president elect 1980-1981, president 1981-1982, retired in 1992, and served as a senior
16 judge from 1993 to 2003; and

17 WHEREAS, he was a member of the Mount Airy Lodge No. 141 F&AM and was a Shriner,
18 Emeritus Yaarab Temple, and a former Kiwanian; and

19 WHEREAS, Judge Gunter was a member of Camp Creek Baptist Church where he taught
20 adult men's Sunday school class.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
2 remember and honor the remarkable life and service of the honorable Judge Jack N. Gunter
3 and express its sincerest condolences to his family.
