A RESOLUTION

1 To commend and recognize Corry McNamara; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Corry McNamara, an esteemed resident of Snellville, Georgia, and a junior at
3 Shiloh High School in Gwinnett County, has achieved national recognition for exemplary
4 volunteer service by receiving a 2004 Prudential Spirit of Community Award; and

6 National Association of Secondary School Principals, honors young volunteers across
