A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Monnie Sellars; and for other purposes.

3 as the personification of perfection in her mastery of matters of state and local taxation; and

18 reliability rightfully earned her our honor, respect, and trust over the years; and

19 WHEREAS, her unparalleled organizational and leadership talents, her remarkable patience
20 and diplomacy, her keen sense of vision, and her acute sensitivity to the needs of the citizens
21 of her community and state have earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and
22 associates; and

1 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
2 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be recognized appropriately.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
4 the members of this body commend Monnie Sellars for the almost three and one-half decades
5 of effective, efficient, unselfish, and dedicated service that she has rendered on behalf of
6 Georgia and extend to her their utmost appreciation for her having so purely and truly
7 defined for others the meaning of public servant.
