ADOPTED SENATE

A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging the Board of Natural Resources to forthwith adopt state-wide uniform open season
- 2 dates for dove hunting throughout this state; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, open season dates for hunting doves in this state are established by the Board
- 4 of Natural Resources within a maximum open season of September 1 through March 10 for
- 5 migratory game birds, pursuant to Code Sections 27-3-3 and 27-3-15 of the Official Code
- 6 of Georgia Annotated; and
- 7 WHEREAS, currently, open season dates are established separately and differently by the
- 8 Board of Natural Resources for each of three dove hunting periods for Northern and Southern
- 9 zones of this state; and
- 10 WHEREAS, these nonuniform open season dates are confusing, especially where some
- 11 counties are divided between the Northern and Southern zones; and
- 12 WHEREAS, these problems could and should be eliminated by the Board of Natural
- 13 Resources through the adoption of state-wide uniform open season dates for dove hunting
- 14 throughout this state in accordance with Code Sections 27-3-3 and 27-3-15 of the Official
- 15 Code of Georgia Annotated, consisting of three periods as follows:
- 16 (1) From sunrise on Labor Day to sunset on the second Saturday in September;
- 17 (2) From sunrise on the first Saturday in October to sunset on the second Saturday in
- 18 October; and
- 19 (3) From sunrise on Thanksgiving to sunset on January 15.
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 21 urge the Board of Natural Resources to forthwith adopt state-wide uniform open season dates
- 22 for dove hunting throughout this state as specified above.
