A RESOLUTION

1 Relative to adjournment; and for other purposes.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that, unless otherwise
3 provided by subsequent resolution of the General Assembly, the meeting dates and dates of
4 adjournment for the 2004 regular session of the General Assembly for the period of February
5 26, 2004, through March 8, 2004, shall be as follows:

6	Thursday, February 26	in session for legislative day 26
7	Friday, February 27	in adjournment
8	Saturday, February 28	in adjournment
9	Sunday, February 29	in adjournment
10	Monday, March 1	in session for legislative day 27
11	Tuesday, March 2	in session for legislative day 28
12	Wednesday, March 3	in adjournment
13	Thursday, March 4	in session for legislative day 29
14	Friday, March 5	in session for legislative day 30
15	Saturday, March 6	in adjournment
16	Sunday, March 7	in adjournment
17	Monday, March 8	in session for legislative day 31

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that on and after March 8, 2004, the periods of adjournment
19 of the 2004 session, if any, shall be as specified by subsequent resolution of the General
20 Assembly, except that for the remainder of the 2004 regular session, unless otherwise
21 provided by subsequent resolution, the General Assembly shall adjourn at the close of the
22 legislative day on each Friday on which the General Assembly is in session and shall
23 reconvene on the following Monday.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as authorized by Code Section 28-1-2, the hours for
25 closing and convening the Senate on each day may be as ordered by the Senate; and the
26 hours for closing and convening the House on each day may be as ordered by the House.
