**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT**

1 To amend an Act to provide for the election of members to the Dade County board of
2 education, approved February 6, 1984 (Ga. L. 1984, p. 3575), as amended, so as to revise the
3 districts for the election of members of the board of education; to provide for definitions and
4 inclusions; to provide for method of election; to provide for submission of this Act for
5 preclearance pursuant to Section 5 of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended; to
6 provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
7 other purposes.

8 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

9 **SECTION 1.**

10 An Act to provide for the election of members to the Dade County board of education,
11 approved February 6, 1984 (Ga. L. 1984, p. 3575), as amended, is amended by striking
12 Section 1 of the Act and inserting in lieu thereof a new Section 1 to read as follows:

13 "Section 1. (a) The board of education of Dade County shall be composed of five
14 members to be elected as provided in this Act. For the purpose of electing members of the
15 board of education, Dade County shall be divided into five education districts. Education
16 Districts 1 through 4 shall be and correspond to those four numbered districts described in
17 and attached to and made a part of this Act and further identified as Plan Name: dadeccp1
18 Plan Type: Local User: Shantee Administrator: Dade Co. Education District 5 shall be
19 composed of the entire Dade County school district.

20 (b) When used in such attachment, the terms 'Tract' and 'BG' (Block Group) shall mean
21 and describe the same geographical boundaries as provided in the report of the Bureau of
22 the Census for the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia. The
23 separate numeric designations in a Tract description which are underneath a 'BG' heading
24 shall mean and describe individual Blocks within a Block Group as provided in the report
25 of the Bureau of the Census for the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of
26 Georgia. Any part of Dade County not included in any such district described in that

1 attachment shall be included within that district contiguous to such part which contains the
2 least population according to the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of
3 Georgia. Any part of Dade County described in that attachment as being in a particular
4 district shall nevertheless not be included within such district if such part is not contiguous
5 to such district. Such noncontiguous part shall instead be included within that district
6 contiguous to such part which contains the least population according to the United States
7 decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia. Except as otherwise provided in the
8 description of any district, whenever the description of such district refers to a named city,
9 it shall mean the geographical boundaries of that city as shown on the census map for the
10 United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia."

11 **SECTION 2.**

12 Said Act is further amended by striking Section 4 of the Act and inserting in lieu thereof a
13 new Section 4 to read as follows:

14 "Section 4. (a) The members of the board of education who were elected at the general
15 election in November 2002 shall continue in office for the terms to which they were elected
16 and until successors are elected and qualified as provided in this Act. The members of the
17 board of education who were elected at the general election in November 2000 shall
18 continue in office for the terms to which they were elected and until successors are elected
19 and qualified as provided in this Act.

20 (b) Successors to the members of the board of education of Dade County from Education
21 Districts 3, 4, and 5 shall be elected at the state-wide general election in 2004. Such
22 members shall take office on January 1 following their election for terms of four years and
23 until their successors are elected and qualified.

24 (c) Successors to the members of the board of education of Dade County from Education
25 Districts 1 and 2 shall be elected at the state-wide general election in 2006. Such members
26 shall take office on January 1 following their election for terms of four years and until their
27 successors are elected and qualified.

28 (d) Successors to members elected under subsections (b) and (c) of this section shall be
29 elected at the state-wide general election next preceding the expiration of such terms of
30 office and shall take office on January 1 following their election for terms of four years and
31 until their successors are elected and qualified.

32 (e) Education Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 as they existed on January 1, 2004, shall continue
33 to be designated as Education Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5, respectively, but as newly
34 described under this Act, and, on and after the effective date of this Act, such members of
35 the board serving from those former education districts shall be deemed to be serving from
36 and representing their respective districts as newly described under this section."

SECTION 3.

1

2 The Board of Education of Dade County shall through its legal counsel cause this Act to be
3 submitted for preclearance under Section 5 of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as
4 amended, and such submission shall be made to the United States Department of Justice or
5 filed with the appropriate court no later than 30 days after the date on which this Act is
6 approved by the Governor or otherwise becomes law without such approval.

SECTION 4.

7

8 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
9 without such approval.

SECTION 5.

11 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
