A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 16-13-32.6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 drug-free commercial zones and punishment of unlawful conduct therein, so as to adopt and
3 incorporate all drug-free commercial zones that have been adopted by counties and
4 municipalities and registered with the Department of Community Affairs on or before a
5 certain date; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting
6 laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Code Section 16-13-32.6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to drug-free
10 commercial zones and punishment of unlawful conduct therein, is amended by striking
11 subsection (f) and inserting in lieu thereof a new subsection (f) to read as follows:

12 "(f) The General Assembly hereby adopts and incorporates into this Code section all
13 drug-free commercial zones which have been adopted by municipal or county ordinance
14 and entered in the register of the Department of Community Affairs as provided for in
15 subsection (d) of this Code section on or before March ~~22, 1999~~ 1, 2004."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
18 without such approval.

19 **SECTION 3.**

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
