A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Title 19 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to domestic relations,
- 2 so as to require that courts must determine matters of adoption and child custody within 90
- 3 days after the final hearing in such cases; to provide for related matters; to provide for an
- 4 effective date and applicability; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Title 19 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to domestic relations, is
- 8 amended by adding a new subsection (j) to Code Section 19-8-14, relating to timing of
- 9 adoption hearing, to read as follows:
- 10 "(j) All adoption proceedings shall be decided and determined by the court no later than
- 90 days following the conclusion of the final hearing on such matters."
- 12 SECTION 2.
- 13 Said title is further amended by adding a new Code Section 19-9-8 to Article 1 of Chapter 9,
- 14 relating to general provisions concerning child custody proceedings, to read as follows:
- 15 "19-9-8.
- All child custody proceedings shall be decided and determined by the court no later than
- 90 days following the conclusion of the final hearing on such matters."
- 18 SECTION 3.
- 19 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2004, and shall apply to all adoption and child
- 20 custody cases pending on and after such date.
- SECTION 4.
- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
