A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the Georgia Federation of Women's Clubs; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the club was first organized in Atlanta in 1896 and currently boasts a
3 membership of over 4,000 strong spread across 126 clubs in Georgia; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the club is an affiliate of the General Federation of Women's Clubs and is one
5 of the largest civic women's volunteer organizations in the world; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the organization promotes community service by the local club women,
7 encouraging them to make a difference in the areas of the arts, education, women's health
8 issues, finance, and safety issues concerning children and senior citizens; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the organization also encourages its members to address global relations and
10 international affairs through the United Nations, International Childreach, and Operation
11 Smile programs; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the General Federation of Women's Clubs and the Georgia Federation of
13 Women's Clubs have made children's issues their major focus and emphasis this year; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the Georgia Federation of Women's Clubs public affairs program has placed
15 special emphasis on women in public service.
- 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
17 the members of this body commend the Georgia Federation of Women's Clubs for their
18 generous volunteer service and selfless efforts to improve the quality of life within their
19 communities.
