A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Grayson Elementary School on its Pay for Performance Award; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, on January 8, 2004, State Superintendent of Schools Kathy Cox and the State
4 Board of Education approved award amounts for 68 of the state's Pay for Performance (PfP)
5 schools totaling \$5,702,222.00 for the 2002-2003 cycle; and

6 WHEREAS, Pay for Performance is an excellent incentive program because it inspires a
7 local school to set high goals and then challenges the teachers and staff to work hard together
8 over the next year to attain those goals; and

9 WHEREAS, the Pay for Performance program is a voluntary school improvement program
10 designed to promote exemplary school achievement as well as faculty collaboration; and

11 WHEREAS, the 68 schools that received the Pay for Performance awards for the 2002-2003
12 school year went the extra mile to participate in this program; and

13 WHEREAS, Grayson Elementary School proved it was not afraid to set higher standards for
14 itself and worked hard to reach its goals of excellence; and

15 WHEREAS, awards are made to schools, not to individuals, and, for the determination of
16 exemplary performance at the school site, criteria relate to the overall educational
17 performance of the school in areas related to student outcomes and achievement; and

18 WHEREAS, for its exemplary efforts and achievement, Grayson Elementary School was
19 awarded \$175,599.58 by the State of Georgia.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
2 the members of this body commend Grayson Elementary School for its designation as a Pay
3 for Performance school and its collective effort in winning the hard earned award.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
5 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Grayson Elementary School.
