The House Committee on Governmental Affairs offers the following substitute to HB 1206:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 45-11-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 persons who may not engage in the bail bond business, so as to change the classes of persons
- 3 so prohibited; to allow attorneys to have an ownership interest in a bail bond business; to
- 4 prohibit attorneys from engaging in the day-to-day operation of a bail bond business; to
- 5 prohibit attorneys from representing clients who obtain bond from a bail bond business in
- 6 which the attorney has an ownership interest; to provide for a criminal penalty; to provide
- 7 for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

- 10 Code Section 45-11-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to persons who
- may not engage in the bail bond business, is amended, by striking the Code section in its
- 12 entirety and inserting the following in place thereof:
- 13 "45-11-8.
- 14 (a) It shall be unlawful for any elected official, officer of the court, law enforcement
- officer, or attorney in this state to engage either directly or indirectly in the bail bond
- 16 business.
- 17 (a) It shall be unlawful for the following persons to engage either directly or indirectly in
- 18 <u>the bail bond business:</u>
- 19 (1) Elected officials;
- 20 (2) Jailers or persons employed in any jail;
- 21 (3) Law enforcement officers or employees of any law enforcement department; or
- 22 (4) Employees of a court or employees of the clerk of any court.
- 23 (b) An attorney who has an ownership interest in a bail bond business is not permitted to
- 24 participate in or be associated with the day-to-day operations of the bail bond business,
- 25 <u>including but not limited to the charging or collecting of surety fees and the surrender or</u>

1 capture of the principal and may not hold himself or herself out as a signer of sureties of

- bonds.
- 3 (c) An attorney may not represent a client in a criminal case in which the bail bond
- 4 <u>business in which the attorney has an ownership interest has posted the bond for said client;</u>
- 5 nor may an attorney represent a client in any civil forfeiture matter arising out of the
- 6 forfeiture of any bond which was posted in the underlying criminal case by the bail bond
- 7 <u>business in which the attorney has an ownership interest.</u>
- 8 (b)(d) Any person who violates this Code section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor."

9 SECTION 2.

10 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
